The Town of Red Hook Conservation Advisory Council (CAC) is pleased to announce the availability of the Ruth Oja Environmental Scholarship offered through the Community Foundations of the Hudson Valley. Established by the Red Hook Town CAC in honor of Ruth Oja this scholarship is available to students who are residents of Red Hook, NY who are college bound graduating high school seniors or the home-schooled equivalent pursuing studies in environmental science or a related discipline or who have demonstrated a sensitivity to the environment through leadership/participation in pro-environmental programs like recycling, land conservancy, environmental cleanup projects, etc. This scholarship shall be applied to tuition costs at an accredited college university or trade school. Award amount is \$500.

Scholarship applications are available online to interested, eligible students and must be submitted by April 1<sup>st</sup>.
