- In response to our invitation, Linda Keeling attended the meeting to voice her concerns about the Wetlands Walk. We provided information to her inquiries.**
- Having walked and observed the condition of the Tivoli Bay trail between Bard College and Tivoli, we noted improvements which need to be done to make it usable as a bicycle trail. Trees need to be removed and bridges need attention. We will contact Bard College and DEC to try to facilitate the needed work.**
- After noting that a sidewalk and graveled walkway along Linden Ave. does exist as a route between the H. S. and the Rec. Park, we are stongly urging the installation of a light of some type to be placed at the striped Linden Ave. crossing.**
- John has completed an updated history of the Red Hook trails system.**
- We discussed establishing a Historic District Hucklebush Rail Bed Trail along Firehouse La., Elisabeth St., Thompson St., and Fisk St. There is also the possibility of connecting this area (focusing on historic buildings next to Elisabeth St. and Firehouse La.) with the Quadricentennial Celebration scheduled for next year. We will discuss this with the Village of Red Hook officials and seek their approval.**
- The next meeting is scheduled for 7:30 PM, Thurs., Sept. 4, 2008 at Red Hook Town Hall.**
