MEETING MINUTES — 7:30 PM, Thur. July 5, 2012

In Attendance: Howie Callies, Bruce Cuttler, John Kuhn, liaison Brenda Cagle,

- We are planning the establishment of a trail from the northwest corner of the new Rec. Park to the intersection of Aspinwall Rd. and Chestnut St. It would be approx. 225 ft. long and would pass through a wooded and partially wet area. The following is a list of items to be addressed for the establishment of the trail:
  - remove accumulated yard debris from neighborhood dumping activities.
  - place no dumping signs along side of road.
  - cut and remove fallen limbs and selected small trees from proposed trail.
  - fill and level uneven depressions on the dry areas.
  - place finish material on trail.
  - construct and place a bridge and/or boardwalk over 60-80 ft. of wet area.
- Howie has begun initial clearing along Aspinwall Rd. The Town Hwy. Dept. removed debris from the area. Shortly thereafter, more debris was dumped there by parties unknown.
- Bruce and Howie bushhogged a trail around the edge of the new Rec. Park area. The Rec. Park staff mowed it to a shorter, more finished condition. Future plans include using it for cross-country running and training as well as exercise for other sports.
- Bruce offered to be a representative from our community for the Dutchess Co. Bicycle-Pedestrian Advisory Committee.

The next meeting is scheduled for 7:30 PM, Thur., Aug 2, 2012 at Red Hook Town Hall.
