Call to Order: Rosemarie Zengen, acting Chair at Chairperson's Fredricks' request, called the meeting to order at 4:02 PM. There was quorum. Rosemarie Zengen handed out the minutes to the previous meeting (March 27, 2013).

MOTION: Kathy Douris made a motion to accept the March 27, 2013 minutes. Ralph Frisenda seconded the motion. All agreed.

NEW BUSINESS:

2. **EARTH DAY ARBOR DAY CELEBRATION**

*We decided that we would have three jars at The St. Margaret's table on Earth/Arbor Day: 1 jar for The Basket Raffle (\$150 value), 1 jar for membership and 1 jar for donations. Raffle tickets would be \$1.00 each or 6 for \$5.00. Winners will not have to be present to win.

*Ralph Frisenda will make The Pasta Salad for The Arbor/Earth Day Luncheon. He will be reimbursed after he submits a receipt. Chairman Paul Fredricks usually mans The St. Margaret's' Booth on Town Festival Days. Ralph Frisenda was asked to man the booth for Arbor/Earth Day. He agreed.

*Len Miller and The 4-H Gentle Giants called Rosemarie Zengen and asked if donations could be asked for from the people who ride in the carriages since it costs nearly \$600.00 a month to shoe and care for the horses. Rosemarie Zengen will attach a donation basket to the carriages on Arbor/Earth Day for the Parade. The Town of Red Hook Tree Commission Banner will be placed on one side of the carriage that the dignitaries ride in and on the other side we will put The St. Margaret's Banner, that we will get from Chairperson Fredricks. Rosemarie Zengen and Ralph Frisenda asked Trilby Sieverding if she would bring two of her beautiful hens and some eggs to sell on Arbor Day. She volunteered.

*It was agreed that the first stop made by The Horse and Carriages would be St. Margaret's Home since the first Commemorative Trees planted by The Town of Red Hook Tree Commission were at St. Margaret's Home. The first was for The Hannaford's Supermarket. The second was for Marcy Appell. Supervisor Sue Crane will M.C. a dedication of a brass plate in Marcy Appell's honor at The St. Margaret's Home North Lawn at approximately 9:15 AM on Arbor/Earth Day (4/27/13). Supervisor Crane will introduce our County Executive- Marcus J. Molinaro, Legislator Benjamin Traudt, and Dr. James Ross (The Town Board's liaison to The St. Margaret's Committee).

*Supervisor Crane will introduce the dignitaries present and then instruct everyone to proceed to The Tennis Courts at The Red Hook Recreation Park. A White Oak Tree will be planted near The Tennis Courts for County Executive Marcus J. Molinaro, his daughter- Abigail and his son- Jack. Hopefully, Congressman Chris Gibson and Senator Terry Gipson will be at the Red Hook Recreation Park to congratulate The County Executive, Supervisor Sue Crane, The Town of Red Hook Tree Commission Chairperson, Nancy Guski, and The Town of Red Hook for their dedication in observance of Arbor/Earth Day.

*Denise Lamberti, a local resident, has also shown interest about being on The Committee.
