SUBJECT: IMPLEMENTATION OF THE WORKING GROUP REPORT
RECOMMENDATIONS

One Hundred Fifty-Fourth Report: September, 2017

At weekly meetings 8/25/17, 9/1/17, 9/8/17 and 9/15/17 the Inter-Municipal Task Force continued its discussion of large commercial extraction of natural resources in the Town of Red Hook, and strategies for the implementation of the Moratorium declared by the Red Hook Town Board 8/23/17 by Resolution declaring a local law placing a 12 month Moratorium on Large Scale Commercial Extractive Operations in the Town of Red Hook.

The Task Force has also been studying and reviewing a draft of a proposed local law, D, for 2017, (revised 8/19/16, again 6/7/17, and again 8/25/17) captioned "A Local Law to Establish a New Chapter 79 of the Town Code to be known as "Food Trucks", and to Amend Chapter 143 of the Code of the Town of Red Hook Entitled "Zoning" to Prohibit Drive-Thru Businesses and Formula Businesses, and to Replace the B1 District in Upper Red Hook with a Hamlet Business (HB) District"
