At weekly meetings 4/28/17, 5/5/17, 5/12/17 and 5/19/17 the Inter-Municipal Task Force continued to review proposed language to amend the current zoning law regarding signs in the Town of Red Hook, and continued to discuss a proposed zoning law regarding Solar Energy. The Task Force also reviewed revisions by Greenplan, Inc. to the proposed Hamlet Business District, adjacent to the Hamlet of Upper Red Hook, in a Draft dated 5/2/17 (4 pages), along with proposed amendments to the Use Table for Zoning Districts in the Town of Red Hook (7 pages), and the District Schedule of Area and Bulk Regulations (1 page).
