SUBJECT: IMPLEMENTATION OF THE WORKING GROUP REPORT
RECOMMENDATIONS

One Hundred Fifty-Ninth Report: February, 2018

At weekly meetings on 1/26/18, 2/2/18, 2/9/18, 2/16/18 and 2/23/18 the Inter-Municipal Task Force discussed the Local Waterfront Revitalization Plan (LWRP) for the Town of Red Hook, based on a state grant obtained for the purpose of updating our LWRP; began a review of proposed zoning being considered by the Village of Red Hook, to be coordinated with zoning in the adjacent Town of Red Hook, as contemplated by the Working Group Report of 2004; and reviewed our recently enacted Solar Energy Law for the Town of Red Hook in anticipation of a Scenic Hudson, Inc. sponsored symposium at FDR Library in Hyde Park, 3/27/18, "to provide critical insight into how we can navigate the tough issues surrounding the rapid development of solar energy projects in the region in support of meeting New York State's ambitious carbon emissions reduction goals".
