The last Business Meeting of the year of the Town Board of the Town of Red Hook, Dutchess County, New York was convened in public session at the Town Hall, 7340 South Broadway, Red Hook at 10:00 a.m.

Supervisor Crane welcomed everyone to the meeting and opened with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Business Manager Deb Coon informed the Board that we received \$19,000 in disaster aid for the Rec. Park to offset the expenditures for the repair due to the hurricane. Mortgage tax revenue was lower than we budgeted but not as low as we anticipated based on the first receipt. The Highway Department is in good shape and we received money to aid in the bridge repair. The contingency fund aided us in our budgeting and the fund balance will be in good shape going into 2013. The books will be closed the second week in February and Deb will prepare the annual report. She explained the tasks the Business Office will be involved with.

Supervisor Crane wants to talk with the Board about the Planning Board vacancy due to the retirement of Betty Mae VanParys. She also told the Board that she spoke with Code Enforcement Officer Steve Cole and Building Inspector Bob Fennell regarding the decrease in hours for Mr. Fennell.
