## REFUNDING BOND RESOLUTION DATED APRIL 27, 2016

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF REFUNDING BONDS OF THE TOWN OF RED HOOK, DUTCHESS COUNTY, NEW YORK IN AN AGGREGATE PRINCIPAL AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$2,000,000 PURSUANT TO THE LOCAL FINANCE LAW, AND DELEGATING CERTAIN POWERS IN CONNECTION THEREWITH TO THE TOWN SUPERVISOR

Object or purpose: The resolution authorizes the issuance of refunding bonds for the purpose of refunding the Public Improvement (Serial) Bonds, Series 2009A of the Town of Red Hook, Dutchess County, New York, dated June 4, 2009 in the original aggregate principal amount of \$2,211,000 (the "2009 Bonds"). The 2009 Bonds represented serial bonds combined for purposes of sale, including the aggregate principal amount of \$1,783,000 issued pursuant to a Bond Resolution dated July 8, 2003 to finance the acquisition of interest or rights in real property for the preservation of open spaces, and the aggregate principal amount of \$428,000 issued pursuant to a Bond Resolution dated April 10, 2007 to finance the acquisition of a parcel of real property for the public purposes of the Town. The 2009 Bonds have a final maturity date of June 1, 2035.

Refunding Financial Plan: The preliminary Refunding Financial Plan set forth in such resolution assumes the issuance of Refunding Bonds in a principal amount of \$1,940,000 to refund the 2009 Bonds maturing on and after June 1, 2020, with a final maturity of June 1, 2035, pursuant to Section 90.10 of the Local Finance Law, for the purpose of achieving present value in debt service savings. The final Refunding Financial Plan will most likely be different from the preliminary plan and authority is delegated to the Town Supervisor, as chief fiscal officer, to determine matters relating to the issuance of the Refunding Bonds including the amount of the Refunding Bonds to be issued and the maturities and terms thereof. The Refunding Bonds are to be sold at competitive sale or at private sale as shall be determined by the Town Supervisor. The issuance of the Refunding Bonds is subject to the approval of the New York State Comptroller as to the present value savings in debt service.

Period of Probable Usefulness: The last installment of the Refunding Bonds shall mature not later than the expiration of the remaining period of probable usefulness of the purposes for which the 2009 Bonds to be refunded were issued, or in the alternative, the weighted average remaining period of probable usefulness of all objects or purposes (or classes of objects or purposes) financed with all of the bonds to be refunded, in accordance with the provisions of the Local Finance Law. As of the date of issuance of the Series 2009 Bonds the weighted average period of probable usefulness of the objects or purposes or class of objects or purposes financed with the Series 2009 Bonds was 26.08 years.

Maximum Amount of Obligations to be Issued: Presently estimated to be \$2,000,000.
