Sealed bids for the furnishing of all labor and material necessary for **NYS Route 9 Pedestrian Improvements** will be received by the Town of Red Hook until **3:00 pm** local time **February 27, 2017 at the Office of the Town Clerk**, Town of Red Hook, 7340 S Broadway, Red Hook NY 12571 at which time and place they will be publicly opened and read aloud.

Bids will be received for the following Contract: PIN 8761.24 - NYS Route 9 Pedestrian Improvements.

The Information for Bidders, Specifications and other Contract Documents may be reviewed and obtained on or after Friday February 3, 2017 in the Office of the Town Clerk, Town of Red Hook, 7340 S Broadway, Red Hook NY 12571 along with any associated Bid Addenda for a \$100 deposit. CD's containing the Contract Documents may be obtained free of charge starting Friday February 3, 2017.

Each bid must be accompanied by bid security in the amount of five percent (5%) of the gross amount of the bid payable to the Town of Red Hook as a guarantee that if the bid is accepted, the Bidder will enter into a contract within the stipulated time with all required bonds and other documents in accordance with the bid documents. No bidder may withdraw their bid within forty-five (45) days after the actual date of opening therefore.

The Bidder to whom the Contract is awarded will be required to furnish performance and payment bonds from an acceptable Surety Company for an amount not less than 100% of the accepted bid.

This project is a Locally Administered Federal Aid Project (LAFAP) and must comply with the Procedures for Locally Administered Federal Aid Projects (PLAFAP) as outlined in the NYSDOT PLAFAP Manual. The project contains Affirmative Action Goals and reporting requirements. NYSDOT Standard Specifications must be followed on a Federal Aid project. This project is subject to the provisions of Section 103 of the General Municipal Law and subsequent amendments, and all Federal requirements. This contract must be constructed in accordance with NYSDOT Standard Specifications, Construction and Materials, officially finalized and adopted on January 1, 2017 as posted on the New York State Department of Transportation's website. The successful bidder and all subcontractors will be required to complete the New York State Uniform Contracting Questionnaire (CCA-2) online and the prime contractor and subcontractors will be required to use NYSDOT Civil Rights Software, "Equitable Business Opportunity Solution (EBO).

All contract work shall be completed within 120 days from receipt of Notice to Proceed unless such period is extended by the Owner as provided herein.

There is no Disadvantaged Business Utilization Goal for this project. EEO Goals for this project are 6.4% Minority and 6.9% Female. There is no M/WBE language or requirements, residence or geographical restrictions or requirements or Project Labor Agreement requirements associated with this project.

Owner's Rights Reserved: The Town of Red Hook, reserves the right to reject any or all bids and to waive any informality or technicality in any bid in the interest of the Town of Red Hook.

Statement of Non-Collusion: Bidders are required to execute the non-collusion bidding certificate attached to the bid documents pursuant to Section 103-d of the General Municipal Law of the State of New York.
