NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the bond resolution, a summary of which is published herewith, has been adopted by the Town Board of the Town of Red Hook, Dutchess County, New York on the 23rd day of August, 2017, and the validity of the obligations authorized by such resolution may be hereafter contested only if such obligations were authorized for an object or purpose for which the Town of Red Hook is not authorized to expend money or if the provisions of law which should have been complied with as of the date of publication of this notice were not substantially complied with, and an action, suit or proceeding contesting such validity is commenced within twenty (20) days after the date of publication of this notice; or if such obligations were authorized in violation of the provisions of the Constitution of New York.

### BOND RESOLUTION DATED AUGUST 23, 2017

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF SERIAL BONDS OF THE TOWN OF RED HOOK, DUTCHESS COUNTY, NEW YORK IN AN AGGREGATE PRINCIPAL AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$69,000 PURSUANT TO THE LOCAL FINANCE LAW TO FINANCE ACQUISITION OF EXISTING LIGHTING FIXTURES FOR THE TOWN GENERAL LIGHTING ACCOUNT AND CONSOLIDATED LIGHTING DISTRICT IN THE TOWN OF RED HOOK, AND DELEGATING CERTAIN POWERS IN CONNECTION THEREWITH TO THE TOWN SUPERVISOR

Objects or purposes: The Bond Resolution authorizes (1) the acquisition of existing lighting fixtures for the Town's General lighting account from Central Hudson Gas & Electric, at an estimated maximum cost of \$24,000; and (2) the acquisition of existing lighting fixtures for the Consolidated Lighting District from Central Hudson Gas & Electric, at an estimated maximum cost of \$45,000. The aforesaid purposes constitute Type II actions as defined under the State Environmental Quality Review Regulations, 6 NYCRR Part 617, which are determined under SEQRA not to have a significant impact on the environment.

Period of Probable Usefulness: Five (5) years pursuant to subdivision 35 of paragraph (a) of Section 11.00 of the Local Finance Law. The obligations authorized by the Bond Resolution will not be in excess of five years from the original date of issuance of such obligations.

Maximum Amount of Obligations to be issued: The Town Board plans to finance the total cost of said purposes by the issuance of serial bonds of the Town in an amount not to exceed \$69,000, hereby authorized to be issued therefor pursuant to the Local Finance Law.

Delegation: The power to authorize bond anticipation notes in anticipation of the issuance of the serial bonds authorized by this resolution, determine the form and terms of said serial bonds, and take certain other actions is delegated to the Town Supervisor, as Chief Fiscal Officer.
